First of all, we would like to thank you and tell you that we appreciate the cooperation you have shown with the implementation of your new automated garbage collection service. Each resident has received a 95-gallon polycart for the disposal of your household garbage and yard clippings. Your regular collection days are still **Tuesday and Friday (cart contents only)** and your **heavy trash day is the 4th Friday of the month**. As the costs associated with backdoor service have dramatically increased, this new, state-of-the-art trash collection system allows Republic Services to continue to provide twice per week service at a reasonable cost per month. Additional carts are available upon request. (See attached information sheet for details). If you have a disability or are unable to push the cart to the street, please contact our customer service department to make arrangements. The Woodlands Township, The City of Conroe, The City of Houston and Summerwood all currently use this system.

There has been some confusion as to the rules associated with this type of service. We have attached, for your convenience, an information sheet that hopefully addresses any questions that you may have.

All polycarts should be placed at the curbside, within three feet of the street, for collection **no later than 7:00 AM** on your collection days. Curbside refers to the area at or near the roadway. The handle of the cart should be placed away from the street so that the lid opens on the street side.
