Summary of Events

Alarms:

Deputies responded to 20 residential alarms that were cleared as false alarms.

Traffic Enforcement:

Deputy conducted numerous traffic stops and traffic initiatives throughout the contract during the month in the interest of public safety and in an attempt to reduce the risk of motor vehicle accidents.

Tournament Trails Dr/Walden Forest Dr. – Deputy conducted a traffic stop which was later changed to a DWLI call. Investigation revealed the Defendant was operating a motor vehicle with an invalid driver’s license. The Defendant was then arrested and booked into jail for DWLI with a prior conviction and an open warrant. Arrest report was completed.

Contract Checks & Park Checks:

Deputies conducted 159 combined contract and other miscellaneous checks in the contract during the month.

Burglary of a Motor Vehicle:

7800 Silver Lure Dr. – Deputies responded to a burglary of a motor vehicle call. Investigation revealed two unknown suspects (s) unlawfully entered several vehicles in the driveway, stole items and fled. Report completed.

18000 Polo Meadow Dr. – Deputy responded to a burglary of a motor vehicle call. Investigation revealed an unknown suspect(s) made unlawful entry into the Complainant's unlocked vehicle, stole items and fled. Report completed.

18000 Half Volley Cr. – Deputy responded to a burglary of a motor vehicle call. Investigation revealed an unknown suspect(s) made unlawful entry into the Complainant's unlocked vehicle, stole items and fled. Report completed.

Stolen Vehicle:

19000 Dockside Hill Ln. – Deputy responded to a stolen vehicle call. Investigation revealed the Complainant wanted to report that a known person had stolen his vehicle after not keeping up with the payments on a lease agreement they made. Deputies were not able to make contact with the Suspect. The Complainant's vehicle was entered into the system as stolen. Charges on the Suspect are pending further investigation results. Report was completed.

Theft Other:

8500 Silver Lure Dr. – Deputy responded to a theft call. Investigation revealed unknown suspects stole the Complainant's tailgate from a vehicle parked in the Complainant's driveway. Report was completed.

8300 Sports Haven Dr. – Deputy responded to a theft other call. Investigation revealed the Complainant believes their ex-spouse stole their social security card. Complainant wanted to file a report for the missing property. Report was completed.

18000 Aquatic Dr. – Deputy responded to a theft of service call. Investigation revealed the Complainant wanted to report a known Suspect contracted to do work at the residence had taken a check and has not returned to do the work. Through further investigations it was found that the known Suspect claimed the Complainant still owed the Suspect money for work done at the residence. Deputy contacted the Harris County DA's Office who declined charges and stated the matter was civil. Report was completed.

Assault:

18000 Dempsey Oaks Dr. – Deputies responded to an aggravated assault call. Investigation revealed the Complainant was shot by a known person. The Complainant was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The Defendant who shot the Complainant was later charged with aggravated assault and booked into juvenile detention. Further investigation along with a search warrant for the residence assisted in finding multiple narcotics which resulted in multiple arrests to occupants inside the residence. Arrest reports were completed.

Family Disturbance:

7800 Deerwood Lake Dr. – Deputy responded to an aggravated family assault call. Investigation revealed spouses had a verbal argument which became physical. Both parties stated a firearm was used during the assault on each other. Due to conflicting stories and not enough evidence to support either version of the incident, the District Attorney's Office declined any charges. Both parties were separated for the day. Report was completed.

8200 Silver Lure Dr. – Deputy responded to a family disturbance call. Investigation revealed a family member was having a manic episode due to their mental health condition. EMS was able to make the scene and treat the family member without incident. Report was completed.

19000 Hikers Trail Dr. – Deputy responded to a family disturbance call. Investigation revealed family members were involved in a verbal argument where property was damaged. No one claimed physical injury and no charges were pursued. One of the family members was escorted off the property and given a written trespass warning. Report was completed.

8000 Sports Haven Dr – Deputy responded to a family disturbance call. Investigation revealed family members were involved in a verbal argument which ended without injury. No injuries and no charges filed. Report was completed.

Deputy then located the runaway in good health and returned the child to their parents. Deputy then removed the child from the system. Report was completed.
